
# The Power of Provision

of time






as it is written: “None is righteous,

to cover over, in the front



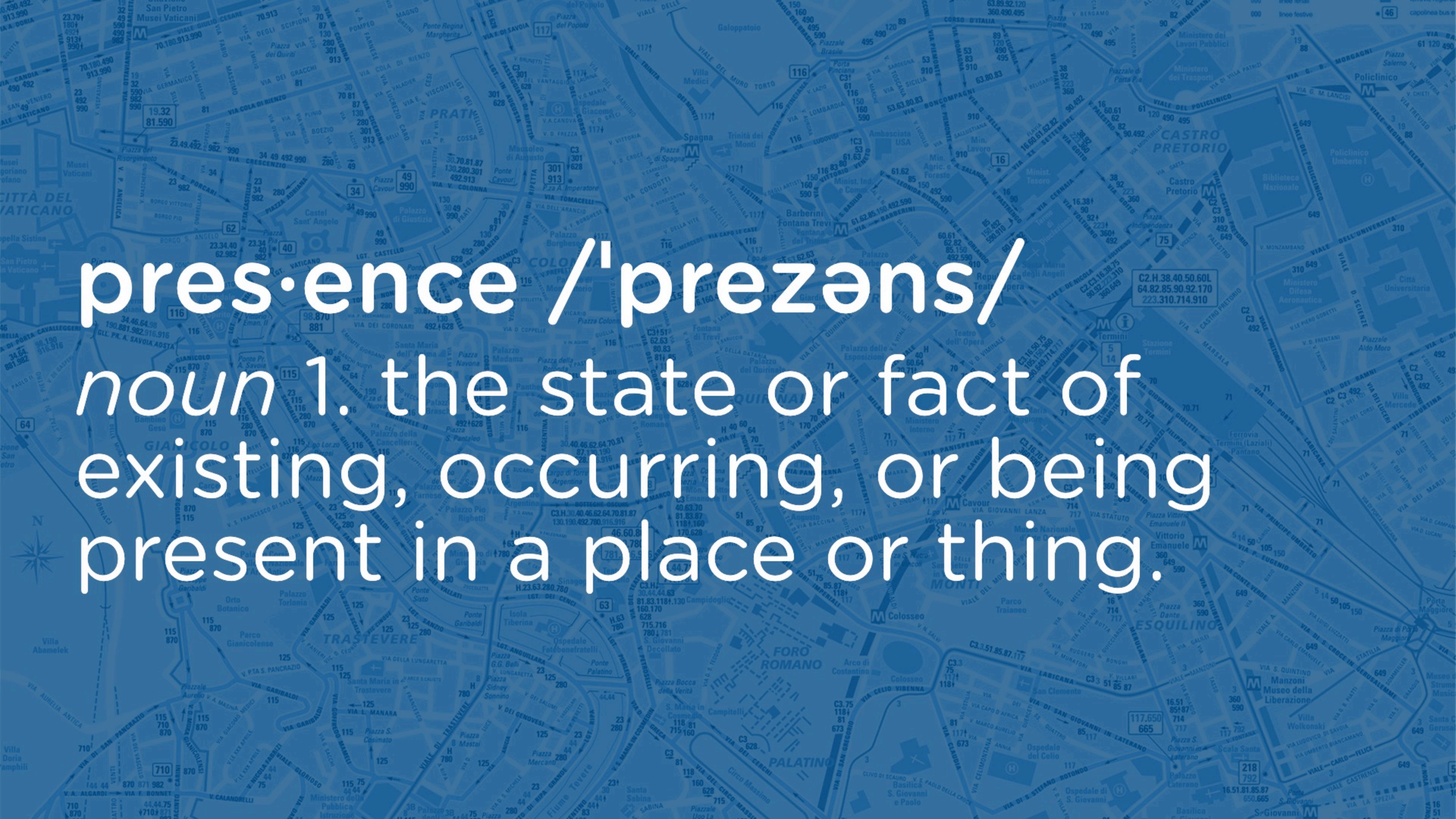


# The Power of Presence

present in a place or thing.








You, however, are not in the flesh but
