### A PRAYER WALK GUIDE TO BE USED WHEN YOU PRAY AROUND YOUR SCHOOLS / WORKPLACE:

Begin your prayer in the vicinity of the main entrance to your school or workplace, then walk to the four corners and each time pray these five prayer focuses or whatever the Holy Spirit brings to your heart.

# MAIN ENTRANCE - TRUTH

"Lord, help those who gather here to study or to work learn how to rightly discern truth and not believe false teachings." For the LORD gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding. Proverbs 2:6

May I be a faithful learner...in my life.

Happily **adore** Our Lord for His goodness to you.

Happily **confess** your sin and receive His abundant mercy.

Happily **thank** God for a recent answered prayer.

Happily **ask** God for your personal needs this coming year.



# 1ST CORNER - SCHOOL BOARD PRINCIPALS / LEADERS AND DECISION MAKERS:

"May those who guide the institutions recognize the God-given responsibility he/she has for the best interest of the community and not focus on individual gain. May they walk in wisdom, integrity, grace and truth." For wisdom will enter your heart, and knowledge will be pleasant to your soul. Discretion will protect you, and understanding will guard you. #### **3RD CORNER - STUDENTS / CUSTOMERS:**

Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. Mt. 7:7; Because a great door for effective work has opened to me, and there are many who oppose me. 1 Cor. 16:9 Lord, especially reach out to the special needs, rejected, failing, those affected by divorce, abuse and neglect, emotional disturbances, bullying, violence, suicide, mental health issues, addiction and protect them from the forces of evil by our prayers (James 1:27).



### 4TH CORNER - ALL:

"May the evil in this world that comes against us through violence, terrorism and all forces of evil be thwarted from this campus. May hope prevail." May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. Romans 15:13

Lord, raise up a people who will worship you in Spirit and in truth (John 4:23-24). We ask in the NAME of JESUS CHRIST, our LORD. AMEN.
